





The **Julia Tutwiler Prison for Women** is a prison for women of the Alabama Department of Corrections (ADOC), located in <u>Wetumpka</u>, Alabama. All female inmates entering ADOC are sent to the receiving unit in Tutwiler. Tutwiler houses Alabama's female death row, which qualifies it for the "maximum security" classification.






