It is now time to begin plans for ordering 2025 – 2026 WMS resource materials. A fillable Resource Ordering Form is included. Note the increase (\$25.00) for the cost of the Mission Education Study Curriculum. The deadline date for submitting orders is Thursday, January 15, 2026.

- 1. Conference Presidents and Second Vice Presidents, you know what works for your Conference members. Continue if the process has been successful.
- Email the final Conference Resource Order to Sister Davis and Sister Wells-Porter.
 Sister Davis will send final copies to President Whiting. President Whiting will forward. the final copies to Sister Catherine.
- 3. Every Conference President sends all collected money to the Treasurer, Sister. Jordan.
- Sister Davis will combine the five Conference orders on a spreadsheet and send a copy to the Treasurer, Sister Jordan; Sister Wells-Porter, President Whiting, and Supervisor McAllister.
- 5. Sister Jordan, Treasurer, will inform Sister Davis when the correct amount due has been received from the Conference Presidents.
- 6. Sister Davis will complete an invoice for each individual order (magazines, Constitution and bylaws, among other documents) and email it to Sister Jordan.
- 7. Sister Jordan places the order. Sister Jordan places all orders at the same time.


