



Note the increase (\$25.00) for the cost of the *Mission Education Study Curriculum*. The deadline date for submitting orders is Thursday, January 15, 2026.

- 1. Conference Presidents and Second Vice Presidents, you know what works for your Conference members. Continue if the process has been successful.
- 2. Email the final Conference Resource Order to Sister Davis and Sister Wells-Porter. Sister Davis will send final copies to President Whiting. President Whiting will forward. the final copies to Sister Catherine.
